Crown King and Black Canyon City Burglars Arrested- Additional Suspect being Sought

Hard work and perseverance by Yavapai County Sheriff's Office Deputies and Detectives have paid off with the arrest of 3 persons involved in burglaries from homes in Crown King and Black Canyon City.

The suspects are identified as 35-year-old Raymond Faires from Ashfork, 52-year-old Carol Dysert from Black Canyon City, and 19-year-old Andrew Mathieson also from Black Canyon City. All were booked at the Camp Verde Detention during various dates within the last 2 weeks.

An additional suspect, identified as 33-year-old Jeffrey Glover, is wanted but has not been located. A warrant was recently issued for his arrest. Glover is 5'06, 170 pounds, short brown hair, and blue eyes. See page 2 for photo further details. Bond is set at \$100,000 dollars.

The booking charges against Faires range from Burglary, Theft, Theft of Means of Transportation, Trafficking in Stolen Property, and Unlawful Use of Means of Transportation. Dysert was booked on charges of Theft and Trafficking in Stolen Property. Mathieson was booked for Theft of Means of Transportation.

The investigation stems from several burglaries occurring in both communities. Items recovered during follow-up by deputies and detectives include a golf cart valued at over \$11,000 dollars, a four person quad vehicle valued at \$5,000 dollars and other miscellaneous property. The investigation is ongoing and additional charges are possible as detectives link this group to other burglaries.
